The **PACT Act** (Promise to Address Comprehensive Toxics) is a bill is named in honor of Sergeant First Class Heath Robinson, an Ohio National Guard service member who died in 2020 due to exposure to toxic chemicals. This bill is a bipartisan effort to expand coverage, treatments, and resources to sick Veterans and others who were impacted by toxins due to service in the U.S. military. The bill passed Congress on August 2, 2022, and was signed into law on August 10, 2022

The PACT Act will bring these changes: Expands and extends eligibility for VA health care for Veterans with toxic exposures and Veterans of the Vietnam War, Gulf War and post-9/11 eras. Adds more than 20 new presumptive conditions for burn pits and other toxic exposures, Adds more presumptive-exposure locations for Agent Orange and radiation. If you're a veteran or survivor, you can file claims now to apply for PACT Act-related benefit. For God and Country!


